Honors Center

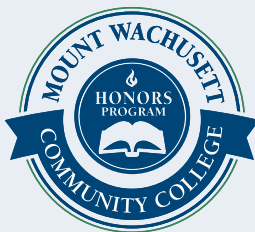
Just for Honors students, the Honors Center is a convenient place to meet, study, and collaborate on projects.
