

## Nursing Education Transfer Compact – Mount Wachusett Community College

Students who meet the Nursing Education Transfer Compact (NETC) by completing an Associate degree in Nursing from a Massachusetts state community college and completing the MassTransfer block or having a previous Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college will receive up to 88 credits in transfer. NETC students do not have to follow Fitchburg State's usual general education requirements. Students are required to complete any courses specified by the RN to BSN major, to complete the global diversity requirement and to meet the minimum 120 credits needed for graduation at Fitchburg State University.
