

**AN ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
MOUNT WACHUSETT COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
AND  
QUINSIGAMOND COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

and Respiratory Care Program**


This articulation agreement refers to the Physical Therapist Assisting and Veterinary Technology Programs at Mount Wachusett Community College (hereby referred to as PTA and VTE at MWCC), and the Radiologic Technology and Respiratory Care Programs at Quinsigamond Community College (hereby referred to as RDT and RS at QCC).

The objective of this Agreement is to provide the opportunity for students from MWCC to enroll in QCC's RDT or RS Programs and students from QCC to enroll in MWCC's PTA or VTE Programs.

1. MWCC will reserve (3) seats for qualified applicants each year into the PTA and VTE programs. The QCC students must meet the academic Admissions requirements for the MWCC PTA or VTE program (contact MWCC Admissions Office for information [admissions@mwcc.mass.edu](mailto:admissions@mwcc.mass.edu)) and have all entrance requirements completed by May 15<sup>th</sup> of the year of entry. QCC will recommend up to 5 qualified applicants to MWCC for final review and acceptance. This agreement begins with the fall 2021 semester.
2. QCC will reserve (3) seats for qualified applicants each year into the RDT and RS programs. The MWCC students must meet the academic Admissions requirements for the QCC RDT or RS program (contact QCC Admission for information [admissions@qcc.mass.edu](mailto:admissions@qcc.mass.edu)) and have all entrance requirements completed by May 15<sup>th</sup> of the year prior to entry. MWCC will recommend up to 5 qualified applicants to QCC for final review and acceptance. This agreement begins with the fall 2021 semester.
3. Students from QCC applying to the MWCC PTA or VTE program will be allowed to take all courses at QCC with the exception of the PTA or RS courses. (See Attachment I)
4. Students from MWCC applying to the QCC RDT or VTE Program will be allowed to take all courses at MWCC with the exception of RDT or VTE courses. (See Attachment III-RDT) This agreement will be subject to a review every year between MWCC and QCC. MWCC and QCC will inform one another of substantive changes in courses or degree requirements.
5. MWCC and QCC agree that all students enrolled in the QCC based programs will be subject to QCC tuition and fee rates for the RDT and RS courses.
6. MWCC and QCC agree that all students enrolled in the MWCC program will be subject to MWCC tuition and fee rates for the PTA and VTE courses.
7. MWCC and QCC will incorporate a summary of this agreement in their official publications.


8. MWCC and QCC will each establish a contact person at each institution (Admissions/Advising staff) to assist in advising students regarding the requirements for this agreement.
9. QCC reserves the right to determine eligibility for the RDT and RS programs.
10. MWCC reserves the right to determine eligibility for the PTA and VTE programs.
11. MWCC selected RDT and RS students will be held to all QCC policies in effect at the time they are admitted. These may include policies governing financial aid, academic status, graduation standards and in-state/out-of-state student status.
12. QCC selected PTA and VTE students will be held to all MWCC policies in effect at the time they are admitted. These may include policies governing financial aid, academic status, graduation standards and in-state/out-of-state student status.
13. To be eligible for this articulation agreement, each student shall take 15 credits in residency at the sending institution.

This Agreement may be terminated by either party with one year's notice. Provisions will be made for those students who are currently enrolled at QCC or MWCC at the time of termination and have been accepted by QCC for RDT or by MWCC for PTA.


