APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Complete, sign and submit the general application to the MWCC Office of Admissions, 444 Green Street, Gardner, MA 01440.
- Applicants must have obtained their high school diploma or HiSET (GED) diploma to be accepted in MWCC.
- MWCC Candidates applying after graduation are to submit an official copy of your high school transcript or bring in your diploma, home school transcript, and/or HiSET (GED) completion certificate to the Office of Admissions.
- If you have attended other college(s) in the past, please contact them to have official transcript(s) sent to: Records Office, MWCC, 444 Green Street, Gardner, MA 01440. Current high school students will be accepted into a major pending verification of high school graduation. For advising purposes, unofficial transcripts from all previously attended U.S. colleges are required. Official transcripts are required if transferring credit or applying to a selective program.
- If you have been awarded an educational certificate from outside the U.S., those documents must be translated and evaluated to U.S. standards through a credential evaluating agency. Agencies can be found on the web at naces.org.
