And

**The Westminster Fire Department**

Based upon the mutual concern for the continued growth of students, and in an effort to provide a continuing articulated program that builds on past learning experience and eliminates unnecessary duplications of instruction, we mutually subscribe to the following:

1. Beginning in the year 2022, students who have successfully completed the Westminster Fire Department training listed below under (A) and who meet all the criteria outlined in this agreement, will be granted MWCC college credits for the courses listed below under (B).

Westminster Fire Rookie School (Westminster Fire Recruit Training)

Westminster Fire Engine Operator (Fire Hydraulics & Water Supply)

(B)

**MWCC Courses to be Articulated**

FST 155 Principles Emergency Services 3 credits  
FST 159 Fire Behavior and Combustion 3 credits

FST 162 Fire Hydraulics and Water Supply  
3 credits

2. Applicants for credit must meet all MWCC admissions requirements and must be an enrolled/registered student in good standing at MWCC including:
  - a. Submit a standard application for admission to the Admissions Office on time (no application fee required).
  - b. Present a transcript to MWCC Advising showing the Westminster Fire Department courses completed.

3. In order for credit to be granted, the student must enroll at the college within 2 years of completing the Westminster Fire Department Training program. In cases where a student's completion of the program exceeds two (2) years, MWCC will determine eligibility on a case by case basis.
4. This agreement will be in effect for three years and is subject to an annual review by both parties.


