Articulation Agreement between Mount Wachusett Community College and Norwich University College of Graduate and Continuing Studies

I. Subject Matter

This Articulation Agreement is by and between Norwich University College of Graduate and Continuing Studies (NUCGCS) and Mount Wachusett Community College.

II. Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to acknowledge that students from Mount Wachusett Community College may transfer a minimum of "60" credits into Norwich University's online degree completion Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice program.

III. Scope

1. To be eligible for application the student must submit proof of having been awarded an associate's degree in Criminal Justice from Mount Wachusett Community College in the form of an official transcript.
2. Students who complete a minimum of 60 semester credits, with a grade of "C" or better will be eligible for the Criminal Justice online baccalaureate program at Norwich University.
3. Credits earned in excess of 60 semester credits will be evaluated on an individual basis for a possible additional transfer credit up to a possible 90 credits into specific requirements of the Criminal Justice degree completion baccalaureate program.

IV. Terms of the Agreement

Norwich University will:

1. Provide Mount Wachusett Community College graduates with a waiver of the application fee and with a tuition scholarship of \$500.00 off the tuition to online degree programs offered by Norwich University at current tuition rates. Programs offered at military tuition assistance levels are not subject to this discount.

Mount Wachusett Community College will:

1. Inform students of the \$500.00 tuition scholarship offered to associate degree graduates of the Criminal Justice program.
2. Inform students that Norwich University will automatically accept 60 credits earned with a "C" or better toward their associate degree in Criminal Justice.
3. Inform students that Norwich University will review all Mount Wachusett Community College Criminal Justice graduates on an individual basis to determine if the student qualifies for additional credits up to 90 credits which is the maximum number of credits Norwich may accept.

V. Addendum


The parties recognize this agreement shall include by reference any future addendum. Such addendum shall be a part of this agreement where the terms of the addendum are approved by both parties at such time.

VI. Period of Agreement


This agreement remains in effect until either party decides this agreement is null and void. The party wishing to dissolve this agreement must give the other party a *sixty-day* written notice of termination of agreement. This agreement must be signed and dated by agents for both parties. The *sixty-day* notice will be in effect upon receipt of the termination of agreement.
